Our plan with this vehicle is to convert it into a refrigerated unit which will give us the opportunity to address those needs in a much more efficient and safe manner. The truck will then deliver fresh and prepared foods to neighborhoods where access to a food bank is difficult due to transportation, hours of service, and limited availability of fresh and prepared foods in local food banks. Also this donation will allow us to increase food access, provide nutritional food that will promote better health, expands capacity to meet existing needs, remove barriers that prevent access to under-served areas and reduces food waste.
