

ANTI-DUMPING NEWS

Certain Aluminum Extrusions

August 27, 2008

On August 18, 2008 the President of the CBSA (Canada Border Services Agency) initiated an investigation into the alleged dumping and subsidizing of **Certain Aluminum Extrusions** originating in or exported from **The Peoples Republic of China**. Subsequently the CITT (Canadian International Trade Tribunal) launched a preliminary inquiry regarding injury to the Canadian industry.

A preliminary finding or injury is expected from the CITT on or before October 17, 2008.

A preliminary determination and or termination regarding dumping and subsidy is expected from the CBSA on November 17, 2008
