Notice of change to RIV payment options

August 21, 2008

Starting **September 15, 2008**, the Registrar of Imported Vehicles will no longer invoice customs brokers of vehicle importers for the RIV fees.

Payment of the RIV fee may be made by one of the following options:

- At the border with a major credit card presented to CBSA
- At the border, by cash or cheque, at a Livingston International office
- Directly on the [RIV web site](#) using Visa or MasterCard
- Mailing a cheque or money order to RIV's head office at:
405 The West Mall, Toronto, ON M9C 5K7

Note: Personal cheques will be held for 10 business days before RIV will release the inspection form for the vehicle. This will use up a portion of your 45-day compliance period.

The Registrar of Imported Vehicles will not issue a federal inspection form with the specific modification information for a vehicle on an unpaid file. It is important that you do not proceed with any modifications on your vehicle until you receive the federal inspection form.
