Subject: Mill analysis or mill test certificates requirement for new or used iron and steel

Distribution: **Brokers, filers, importers, carriers and other interested parties**

On October 2, 2009, a CBP Ruling H068635 was issued regarding the entry requirements of used iron or steel classifiable in Chapter 72, Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (HTSUS) and articles of iron or steel classifiable under heading 7301 to 7307 HTSUS.

CBP held the requirements of 19 CFR 141.89 do not specify the **condition of the goods** as new or used, or that used goods are exempt. Also a statement of internal chemistry of the metal being imported is required in the form of a mill certificate or mill analysis for goods classifiable in those headings. Please be advised that iron or steel classifiable in Chapter 72 or headings 7301 to 7307 will require a mill analysis or mill test certificate at time of importation per 19 CFR 141.89, whether new or used.
