CITT concludes expiry review re Certain Carbon Steel & Stainless Steel Fasteners (Screws)

January 7, 2010

Further to our April 23, 2009 posting regarding this expiry review (a copy of which is appended to this announcement).

The following notice was released by the Canadian International Trade Tribunal (CITT) on January 6, 2010 and circulated by the Canadian Society of Customs Brokers.

The notice refers specifically to Certain Carbon Steel and Stainless Steel Fasteners (Screws) of Taiwan (Chinese Taipei) origin and to Certain Carbon Steel Fasteners (Screws) of China origin.

Certain Fasteners from China and Chinese Taipei

In the matter of an expiry review, pursuant to subsection 76.03(3) of the Special Import Measures Act, of the findings made by the Canadian International Trade Tribunal on January 7, 2005, in Inquiry No. NQ-2004-005, concerning:

THE DUMPING OF CERTAIN FASTENERS ORIGINATING IN OR EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND CHINESE TAIPEI AND THE SUBSIDIZING OF SUCH PRODUCTS ORIGINATING IN OR EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA.

ORDERS

On April 22, 2009, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal gave notice that, pursuant to subsection 76.03(3) of the Special Import Measures Act, it would initiate an expiry review of the above-mentioned findings.

Pursuant to paragraph 76.03(12)(b) of the Special Import Measures Act, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal hereby continues its finding concerning certain carbon steel fasteners, originating in or exported from the People's Republic of China and Chinese Taipei, [excluding the products described in the appendix.](#)

Pursuant to subparagraph 76.03(12)(a)(ii) of the Special Import Measures Act, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal ***hereby rescinds its finding concerning certain stainless steel fasteners originating in or exported from Chinese Taipei.***

CITT initiates expiry review re Certain Carbon Steel & Stainless Steel Fasteners (Screws)

The following notice was released by the Canadian International Trade Tribunal (CITT) and circulated by the Canadian Society of Customs Brokers.

The notice refers specifically to Certain Carbon Steel and Stainless Steel Fasteners (Screws) of Taiwan (Chinese Taipei) origin and to Certain Carbon Steel Fasteners (Screws) of China origin.

Certain Fasteners from China and Chinese Taipei

The Canadian International Trade Tribunal today initiated an expiry review of its findings made on January 7, 2005, in Inquiry No. NQ-2004-005, concerning the dumping of certain carbon steel fasteners from China and Chinese Taipei and the subsidizing of such fasteners from China, as well as the dumping of certain stainless steel fasteners from Chinese Taipei.

On August 20, 2009, the Canada Border Services Agency will determine if there is a likelihood of resumed or continued dumping and subsidizing. In the event of a positive determination, the Tribunal will determine, on January 6, 2010, whether the continued or resumed dumping and subsidizing are likely to result in injury or retardation.
